

Achievements

Bariflo Labs, under virtual incubation with VITTBI was on-boarded with ISB DLabs at the Indian School of Business as on 1st April 2021. DLabs will invest on Bariflo Labs to mentor and scale up technologies developed for waterbody rejuvenation and shrimp farming.

Bariflo also bagged Rs. 20 lakhs seedstage grant from RKVY-RAFTAAT program.

Teralumens Solutions Pvt Ltd from VITTBI was one of the Market Ready startup shortlisted for investment of Rs. 40 lakhs under the TIDE 2.0 Scheme from among the 76 start-ups from 28 TIDE 2.0 Centres following a three-day pitching session before an Expert Committee for the recommendation of the shortlisted proposals. Prakriti (Veon Green Innovations Pvt Ltd) under incubation at VITTBI has been selected among Top 3 finalists for Spark Cash Prize Competition from May-August Cohort of Stanford Seed Spark program. Teralumens Solutions and Blukhet were the other two companies who completed the Seed program successfully in Aug 2021.

Biotechnology Ignition Grant (BIG) – 18 Technical Evaluation team shortlisted LamarkBioTech and Bariflo Labs, under incubation at VITTBI for BIG support in September 2021. VITTBI is a partner to the BIG scheme. Renaura Wellness, Bariflo Labs, Tishya's Medical Devices, Punar Rehab Solutions, Ashva Wearable Technologies and Riverbend from VITTBI were selected as one of Global TOP150 semi-finalists from 3,000+ startups in 42 countries. The Grand Finale will be held on Nov 11, 2021

VITTBI has been chosen as a Knowledge Partner to Deloitte in executingGIZ funded assignment titled Accelerator Programme for Social Enterprises involved in Developing COVID Solutions. AnMoU to this effect was signed in September 2021.



The teams under pre-incubation met on the 1st and 3rd of Sept 2021.






100X VC SESSION


X-PITCH ASIA SUMMIT


LGSI PACTS PROGRAM







The BioNEST center at VIT-TBI organized an online session on HPLC and UPLC on the 28th of Aug 2021. Six students attended the session.







Dr. A. Balachandran was one of the panellists in the session on "Opportunities for Startup Incubators" on the 18th of July 2021 organized by Nativelead.


