

The contest was open for students of VIT through the E-Cell, VIT and VITTBI. Team Aesir comprising of Hemanshi Komati and Vaibhav Gupta from VIT were announced winners on the 5th of April 2016 and took home a cash prize of Rs 20,000.

VITTBI organized an incubation capacity build ing event for around forty faculty members from various institutions in Tamil Nadu on 7th / 8th January'16. This was organized jointly with PSG STEP, Coimbatore with support from Entrepreneurship Development Institute, Govt. of Tamil Nadu. A similar one day Business Incubation Master class for faculty from 4 different institutes in Chennai was organized by VITTBI with the support from TiE Chennai on the 1st of April in VIT.
